GUIDELINES FOR APPLICATION

1. Admission to the PICCR Panel of Arbitrators is made upon an application being made to the PICCR.
2. Candidates wishing to apply must demonstrate an appropriate level of expertise and experience in arbitration and be of good standing and character. In general, applicants will be required to meet the minimum standards set out on the application form.
3. The PICCR reserves the right, in its absolute discretion, to admit or to refuse the admission of any person to the Panel, and to determine the duration of the admission. In exercising its discretion, the PICCR will have regard to, among others, the qualifications, experience and standing of an applicant as well as to the number of arbitrators currently on the Panel from the country in which the applicant is resident.
4. The PICCR will retain / use the candidate's personal information to the extent one or more of the purposes described in this Application Form for which it was collected remains valid and for other legal or business purposes for which the PICCR is required / allowed to retain or use such information.
5. Unless otherwise determined by the PICCR, admission to the PICCR Panel is for a fixed five-year term only. Upon expiration of the five-year period, the Arbitrator may apply for renewal of his/her accreditation by submitting a request for such purpose, for consideration by the PICCR. The PICCR also reserves the right, in its absolute discretion, to remove any person from the PICCR Panel at any time.
